

These are the guidelines for the reopening of Celebration Church on May 31st;

- If you are not ready to attend an in-person service, please do not feel any pressure. The church will support your decision and you will not be criticized. We encourage you to stay home and watch the online service.
- If you are sick, or have been sick within the past two weeks, you should stay home and watch the service online.
- If you have compromised health, it is recommended that you stay home and watch the service online.
- If you are of advanced age, it is suggested that you stay home and watch the service online.
- We will request that you wear masks unless wearing one compromises a health issue that you have. Masks and hand sanitizer will be available.
- We will practice social distancing. Chair rows have been set 6 feet apart. You may sit next to the members of your household or with those who came to church with you. For everyone else, please respect each other by creating a 3-chair distance during the service.
- All touchable surfaces will be thoroughly cleaned and fully disinfected.
- Bathrooms are sanitized and touchless.
- An online bulletin will be available at the church website. There will be no printed bulletins.
- There will be no Celebration Kid's classroom ministry provided. Kids will join their family in the worship service. Celebration Kid's Ministry has carefully prepared "Praise Packs" with materials for your child to participate in the service without interruption. You may also choose to bring a phone or tablet, to be used with earphones, so they can watch Kids Church online. We will continue to provide weekly Kid's Church online content until we are meeting together again in classrooms. If your child becomes restless in the auditorium, the service will be streamed in the foyer and courtyard.
- Rather than passing the offering buckets, you can deposit your offering in the buckets that will be placed at the exits.

Celebration has and will provide a protected facility and an exciting experience. We cannot police everyone and we will not make excessive demands. The information above is in accordance with applicable CDC guidelines and we believe everyone will respect them. We do not assume that there will be media in attendance or any outside scrutiny that day. But if the media arrives, they will not be allowed inside during the service and Pastor Larry will respond to them with a prepared statement. If you engage someone from the media or someone that is openly opposed to the in-person service, be very respectful and kind, portray a non-political posture, and please do not make comments that can be mistaken as an official statement for the church.

We are excited for Pentecost Sunday, May 31, and are believing that the Holy Spirit will work in and through each of us. We appreciate your support of this goal and we highly encourage you to pass this information to others so they can join you in church that day.

So, come expecting that God will meet us. Come believing that the Spirit of God will be obviously present. Pray that every life will be impacted and that a new launch of faith will be birthed in Celebration that day!
